As a Prince2 practitioner and expert in planning institutional projects, managing long-term activities, establishing strategic working relationships, Silvia has worked in partnership with European and international key stakeholders, and prepared strategies for various destinations, including heritage towns such as Pompeii and national parks such as the Vesuvius National Park.
